

Thank you for your interest in Cody's Keyboard Club. We teach children of all ages, levels of experience, talent, and interest how to play electric keyboards. Students are provided with their own keyboards and headsets (for class), and they work on music of their choice. *The program is excellent for beginners.*

The list of benefits of learning to play music is extensive, including helping students develop strong reasoning skills and other "non-music-related" benefits, such as improved self-esteem, spatial-temporal reasoning, and other traits and qualities associated with success.

This is what fuels my teaching method: young students are usually not naturally inspired by the idea of playing the piano itself — but with songs they connect to and a teacher who relates to them, the world of music opens up to them.

We build rapport with each student and design a curriculum to hold their attention as they move through the stages of musical development. We have the flexibility to teach a traditional classical course, a blues course, pop music, songs from video games and TV shows, or any other musical choices students present.

Students who choose their music are more inclined to take ownership of their lessons and musical education, and this ownership is fostered in the club environment.
